BACKGROUND

Care of frail older people with complex conditions will improve only with deliberate intent and planning, requiring European Health Systems to move towards proactive, anticipatory and integrated care.

Population management is emphasized through the use of tools to stratify people with chronic diseases according to their risk and offering support commensurate with this risk.

Effective screening of frailty is key in optimizing care for frail population. Stratification tools identify complex frail and high risk patients and maintain these patients on the radar of the Health Services.

However, a Health System is an intricate network of health care structures with multiple levels of governance. Using extensive screening methods is challenging due to the fact that each particular organization has specific structures, professional roles and governance schemes.


